Site Area: 15 acres
Site 47-E-W-4 site is in the Winter Garden/Avalon area and is fronted by Atwater Bay Drive on the South. The project generally consists of the construction of a two-story tilt-up construction with structural steel framing. The roof system is a single ply membrane over lightweight insulating concrete. The scope includes classrooms, parent and bus loops, teacher and visitor parking, central energy plant, tot and youth lots, play courts, media center, multi-purpose room, art and music labs, food service equipment, and exterior site improvements. The interior and exterior finishes will follow the standard guidelines established by Orange County Public Schools.

The construction schedule is written for 6 days per week of working time. This prototype is 97,000 sq ft with 837 student stations. This is approximately 7-8000 sq ft more space than the typical prior elementary school prototypes. The site has 15 acres with a more developed courtyard hardscape and landscape plan. The perimeter of the property on the North and West has a larger Landscape and Irrigation scope due to buffering the existing homes adjacent to the property. All of this scope has to be incorporated into the same 11-month schedule as the prior prototypes and will require a team effort on everyone's part. Please make sure if you are bidding to include overtime required to meet the schedule for your scope of

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work into your base bid. In our scope meetings as part of GMP development this will be part of the discussions we have with all subcontractors who are competitive. The schedule is posted on Building Connected for review.

 - c) Please submit your bid as a single PDF without passwords or security measures.
 - d) Please do not submit anything besides the required bid forms and your standard proposal format (if desired). Do not submit brochures, cut sheets, or submittals.
 - e) Faxed bids are permitted, but WELBRO is not responsible for faxes not being received on time due to busy fax lines.
 - f) Bids may be hand delivered in sealed envelopes **BEFORE BID 4/27/23 2 PM Local Time.**
 - g) Bids will be opened and read privately.
 - h) **Late bids may not be accepted.**

Failure to supply these documents may result in your bid being disqualified.

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8) Alternates

- a) There are Two (2) Alternates that must be addressed.
 - Alternate 1 – 01 23 00 1.4 A Alternate 1 Resilient Flooring
 - 1. Base Bid: Install Resilient flooring at locations indicated, in accordance with Specification Section 09 65 00" Resilient Flooring"
 - 2. Alternate: Install Luxury Vinyl Tile in place of resilient Flooring, in accordance with Specification Section 09 65 40" Luxury Tile Flooring".
 - Alternate 2 - ADD cost to provide a Payment and Performance Bond.

9) Owner Direct Purchase

- a) All bids must include sales and use tax. Savings that accrue to the owner as a result of directly purchasing materials or equipment shall be adjusted by change order once purchase orders are approved.


10) Jessica Lunsford Act

- a) All subcontractors and suppliers are required to comply with all requirements of the Jessica Lunsford Act once the owner takes possession of the property (TCO).

- q) Will there be any security requirements?
 - a) No, only the JLA badging requirements after TCO.
- q) What is the process for Jessica Lunsford Act?
 - a) You would contact the badging office at OCPS, go through the fingerprinting and background check, then receive a badge. The cost per person is approximately \$92.00. This is per person and would only be required once the TCO is received and we were on the punch list portion of the project.
